This transition marks a significant stride towards establishing circular economies, fostering biodiversity protection, and ensuring sustainability on a global scale, with the added benefit of substantial CO2 reduction.

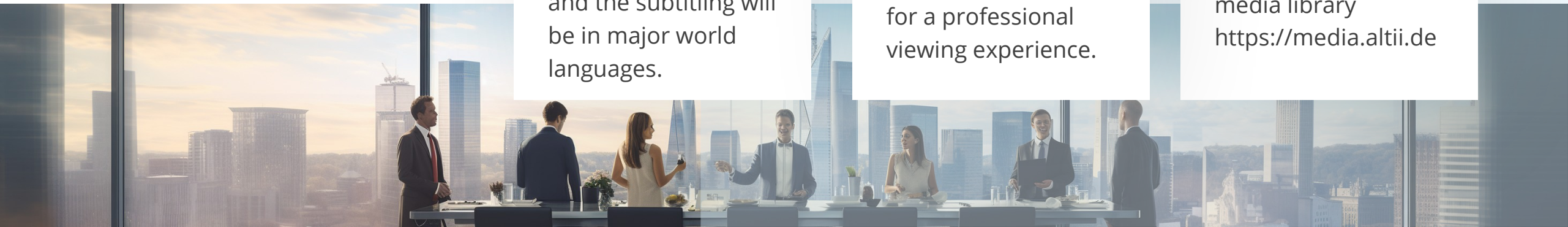
The conference language is English, and the subtitling will be in major world languages.
